## Monthly Car Seat Clinics

The ADPH Injury Prevention Branch conducts car seat clinics on the third Wednesday of each month at the State Farmers Market located at 1655 Federal Drive in Montgomery. These clinics are by appointment only and are typically booked up two months in advance. To schedule an appointment please call (334) 206-3359.

Certified child passenger safety technicians will install car seats for parents and will check car seats that parents have installed themselves. Pregnant women or parents receiving federal assistance such as WIC, AllKids, Food Stamps, or Medicaid, may be eligible to receive a free car seat provided by the Alabama Department of Public Health—please call the number listed above for details.

Parents or guardians must bring a picture ID to their scheduled appointment. Those seeking a free car seat must bring proof of eligibility, and the child



for whom the seat is intended must be present.

The car seat program currently exists in four other locations in the state (Birmingham, Mobile, Tuscaloosa and Huntsville). Please call (334) 206-3359 for more details.
